


# Dear eCAADe Participants!

Welcome to Ankara, Turkey — and to Middle East Technical University (METU/ODTÜ), host of the eCAADe 2025 Conference!

This booklet offers practical information and local tips to help you prepare your trip and make the most of your time in Türkiye. From getting here to getting around, from where to stay to what to taste — here's everything you need to know.

Below is a list of **recommended hotels** near METU (ODTÜ) for your stay during the conference. All prices are per night for single occupancy. You can reach these hotels easily from METU by <u>taxi or metro</u>. (prices can change according to availability, please check for the up-to-date prices)

Movenpick Hotel Ankara – A 4-star hotel located at Söğütözü. Ankara HiltonSA – Central, comfortable, suitable for business travel. City Hotels or Airbnb Options – Kızılay and Bahçelievler areas offer budget alternatives.



### Weather & What to Pack:

Early September in Ankara is mild, with temperatures between 10°C and 30°C.

Pack:


A light jacket or coat

Travel adaptor (Turkey uses Type F plugs, 220V)\*

\*Tap water is not drinkable; use bottled water in Ankara. However, you can safely use the filtered water dispensers available in the Faculty.






We have a lot of food options in the campus if you are interested: **Çarşı** – The campus mall has a lot of different options

**Canteen – Canteens** of every faculty have different options, including the Architecture Faculty

**Central** – Located in Teknokent area, it is the only restaurant that you can fing alchol as alchol is prohibitted in education zones in Türkiye.

Çatı Café: all-you-can-eat buffet with a variety of hot and cold dishes.

#### Notes

METU is Turkey's leading research university with a lush, forested campus and a strong academic heritage. The conference will be held at the Faculty of Architecture, located at the heart of campus.

Pro Tip: In Turkish, METU is called ODTÜ. You'll see this version on signs, maps, and public transportation.

- •Traffic in Turkiye may be functioning more differently than what you are used to. You should pay attention to the following:
  - Being on a crosswalk does not mean that the drivers will acknowledge you and yield.
  - Traffic lights might not be 100% obeyed. That is why we recommend you check the street before crossing.
- •Most people in Ankara speak at least basic English, especially around universities.
- •Use "Hocam" to politely address anyone—it's a unique METU t radition.
- •Due to the banking laws in Turkiye, you may not be able to use your e-wallets such as Apple Pay, Google Wallet, or Paypal. However, the contactless cards you save on your phone should work fine over NFC.
- •Don't hesitate to ask the organizing team for local tips or help.

### By Air:


Fly into Ankara Esenboğa Airport (ESB), which offers both international and domestic connections.

### From the Airport to City Center / METU:

Airport Shuttle (HAVAŞ or BelkoAir): Buses run every 30 minutes to Kızılay and AŞTİ (intercity bus terminal). Havaş usually takes 45 mins. Don't forget to check their departure times, as they change daily.

**Taxi:** Takes 35–45 minutes. Most taxis accept credit cards. Website: www.esenbogataksi.com

**Private Transfer:** Several apps or hotel-arranged services are available.



### Getting Around Ankara!

**Metro:** Take the Koru Metro Line. Nearest stops to METU: ODTÜ (for the A1 entrance) or Bilkent (for the A2 entrance) stations.

\*The Koru Metro Line generally operates from 6:00 AM to midnight (00:00).

**Bus:** EGO Buses to METU, Use Ankarakart for travel. You can use your credit cards but no cash accepted. You can reach METU or nearby metro stations with the following buses:

\*Most EGO buses run from around 6:00 AM until 11:30 PM, but schedules may vary depending on the route. It's recommended to check specific routes for exact timings using the EGO app or website.

From Sincan / Elvankent / Fatih: 511, 512, 521, 532

From Etimesgut / Eryaman: 530, 541

From City Center (Kızılay / Sıhhiye / Beytepe): 339-5, 602-6

From Yenimahalle / AŞTİ area: 419-5

**Taxi & Uber:** Uber is available, but a regular yellow cab will pick you up. Credit cards are usually accepted, but it would be best to ask before travel.

**Dolmuş (Minibus):** Local minivans—cash only and culturally unique!

Available only if you are coming from Ayrancı or Ulus district. From Ayrancı: On weekdays, the Ayrancı-ODTÜ minibus departs from the cafeteria stop until 18:00. After 18:00, it departs from the "Numaralı Yurtlar" (Numbered Dormitories) stop on campus.


Campus Rings (Shuttles): Free blue buses circulating on campus.
